An extensive and thorough search process for the next Shaker Regional Superintendent of Schools has been conducted during the past five months by a School Board Subcommittee in cooperation with a sixteen-member Search Advisory Committee inclusive of numerous constituent groups. The Board Subcommittee has selected two finalist candidates from an initial field of twelve applicants to be further considered for the position of superintendent of schools.

The finalist candidates are Stacy Buckley, Superintendent of SAU 19 (Goffstown, Dunbarton and New Boston) and Trevor Ebel, Superintendent of SAU 63 (Wilton-Lyndeborough). Each of the finalists has significant experience in district-level administration and is fully certified as a superintendent of schools by the New Hampshire Department of Education.

Under the direction of the Shaker Regional School Board, plans are being developed for each finalist to meet with various constituent groups in the Shaker District, participate in community forum, and host a team of Shaker Regional representatives on a site visit to his/her current district. It will be the Shaker Regional School Board's task to review and consider all input and information received, conduct culminating interviews and reach a final decision regarding the position of superintendent for the upcoming academic year.

The School Board's goal is to name a new Shaker Regional School District Superintendent by late March, 2012.
