2 **BOARD COMMITTEES**

3 The Shaker Regional School Board (SRSB) shall have the following standing
4 committees, with the charge and objectives noted:

5

6 1. Buildings and Grounds

7 Charge: To advise and make recommendations to the SRSB as to Shaker
8 Regional School District (SRSD) facilities, including the buildings and the
9 grounds, so as to maintain and promote the best use of such facilities.

10 Objectives:

- 11 1. To identify any life/safety issues that may exist and make
- 12 recommendations to address them.
- 13 2. To prioritize buildings and grounds improvements.
- 14 3. To develop and maintain a Capital Improvement Program (CIP).
- 15 4. To annually inspect all SRSD facilities.
- 16 5. To oversee administration of all SRSD construction projects.
- 17 6. To make recommendations to the Finance Committee regarding
- 18 budget for facilities, maintenance, and improvement.

20 2. Finance

21 Charge: To advise and make recommendations to the SRSB as to fiscal
22 activities and financial planning of the District.

23 Objectives:

- 24 1. To analyze the budget proposal brought forth annually by the
- 25 superintendent and business administrator.
- 26 2. To identify and thoroughly examine any programmatic or staffing
- 27 recommendations made by the administrative team and provide
- 28 counsel to the SRSB.
- 29 3. To annually review the non-bargaining unit salaries and benefits
- 30 and make a recommendation to the SRSB.

32 3. Internal Policy¹²³

33 Charge: To advise and make recommendations to the SRSB as to internal
34 SRSD policies.

35 Objectives:

- 36 1. As required by federal and state law, New Hampshire Department
- 37 of Education regulations, and as recommended by appropriate
- 38 sources or as requested by SRSB, the committee shall review
- 39 existing policies and shall recommend amendments to the SRSB.
- 40 2. As required by federal and state law, New Hampshire Department
- 41 of Education regulations, and as recommended by appropriate
- 42 sources or as requested by SRSB, the committee shall review any
- 43 proposed policies and shall recommend new policies to the SRSB.

45 4. Public Policy

46 Charge: To inform and influence education policy makers on matters that
47 affect and may benefit and/or protect the SRSD on specific issues as

2 Objectives:
3 1. To interact with state agencies, professional associations, and
4 other public education advocates on select public policy issues.
5 2. To interact with and inform New Hampshire legislators and US
6 Representatives and Senators on select proposed legislation at
7 the state and national levels.
8 3. To inform state and federal policy makers as to the impact of
9 educational policies, regulations, funding levels and mechanisms
10 on the SRSD.
11 4. To interact with district taxpayers and the local educational
12 community to gain perspectives and support for public policy
13 advocacy positions of the SRSD.
14
15 5. Student Discipline Review⁴
16 Charge: To conduct hearings on and address any student discipline issues
17 brought forth by the administration and make judgments allowed under -policy
18 or remand an issue to the SRSB.
19
20 6. Transportation
21 Charge: To address matters related to the transportation of SRSD students
22 brought forth by the administration or others.
23 Objectives:
24 1. To review and make judgment on any appeals related to bus stop
25 placements.
26 2. To review and make judgment on any appeals related to bus
27 routes.
28 3. To respond to parent or student appeals of administrative
29 decisions regarding transportation.
30 4. To negotiate and recommend contracts for transportation services
31 to the SRSB.
32
33 7. Athletics/Co-Curricular Revolving Fund
34 Charge: To provide oversight and recommendations to the SRSB of monetary
35 gifts, and associated funds specified for SRSD athletic/co-curricular programs.
36
37 The SRSB Chairperson may create ad hoc and special committees as needed.
38
39 The SRSB Chairperson shall appoint all members of a committee.
40
41 Committees shall meet as needed on issues pertaining to said committee. A committee
42 shall make reports to and recommendations to the SRSB.
