2 **ADVANCED COLLEGE PLACEMENT<sup>1</sup>**

3 Any student who is capable of, and wishes to do, advanced level or college-level courses  
4 while in high school shall be permitted to do so and shall be given assistance in finding  
5 and enrolling in such courses. These courses may be taken at a different public school, at  
6 a private school, a college or a university or through distance education.

8 Any student whose admission to a college-level course is recommended by his/her school  
9 counselor may enroll in a course at an approved college for college credit, at no cost to  
10 the Shaker Regional School District (SRSD). If the student wishes to receive high school  
11 credit for the course, he/she may request permission from his/her Principal to apply the  
12 course toward high school graduation requirements. The Principal shall make a decision  
13 based on the merits of the request and the recommendation of the department.
